





Regulations for the use of inflatable amusement equipment

- 1. Before using inflatable devices (the "**Device**"), you must read the Terms and Conditions.
- 2. Persons using the Device are obliged to follow the instructions of the operator.
- 3. The Device can be used by people in good health.
- 4. The use of the Device is entirely at everyone's own risk and responsibility.
- 5. The Device is only accessible to children aged 3 years and over, with a maximum height of 150 cm. A child under 3 years of age may use the Device under the responsibility of an adult or adult guardian.
- 6. Minors (hereinafter also referred to as "Child" or "Children") use the Device only with the consent and under the control of a parent or adult guardian.
- 7. Children using the Device are fully responsible for their parents or guardians.
- 8. Children staying in the zone and within the Device should be under the constant care of a legal guardian or parent.
- 9. If you feel unwell, stop playing immediately and inform the staff.
- 10. If you notice any abnormality in the functioning of the Device, immediately inform the staff.
- 11. The Device may only be used in clothing free of sharp elements (zippers, studs, hairpins, etc.). The staff may ask you to remove such clothing or refuse access to the Device.
- 12. Persons using the Devices for safety reasons should remove earrings, glasses, pendants and necklaces. Rings, watches, mobile phones, players, money and other valuable or sharp items must be left outside the area of the Device. Take out of your pocket all things that may fall out during play.
- 13. People using the Device are required to take off their shoes and wear socks.
- 14. To avoid abrasions, use the Device in clothing that covers the shoulders and in shorts that reach up to the knees.
- 15. Using the Devices without proper clothing may result in abrasions.









- 16. Entry to the Devices is possible only through a designated entrance. It is not allowed to climb the side walls.
- 17. While using the Device, it is forbidden to push and knock over other participants of the game.
- 18. When entering the slides, you should carefully climb the side stairs, then sit on the edge of the slide and, pushing yourself, slide only on your buttocks or back facing the direction of the slide. It is forbidden to jump down from the slide platform.
- 19. It is forbidden to consume food and beverages or chew gum on the Device.
- 20. For safety reasons, the Device staff may divide children into groups and allow them to enter the obstacle course for a specified period of time, thus limiting the number of people using the Device.
- 21. In the event of a failure of the Device, strong wind or heavy precipitation, the staff is obliged to immediately prohibit the use of the Device and discontinue the current use of the Device without the right to reimbursement of any costs incurred by the persons using the Device. Failure to comply with such instructions may result in serious injury, for which the staff cannot be held responsible.
- 22. It is forbidden to be in the vicinity of machines blowing air into the Device.
- 23. Damage caused intentionally or by non-compliance with these Terms and Conditions or the instructions of the staff is the responsibility of the users or, in the case of minors, their guardians.
